

### **30 FACT BIBLICAL TRUTH ABOUT ALCOHOL.**

- 1, Proverbs 20:1 - Wine is a mocker, strong drink is raging.
- 2, Hosea 4:11 - Intoxicating wine takes away intelligence.
- 3, Hosea 7:5 - God reproves princes for drinking.
- 4, Joel 1:5 - Drunkards awake to see God's judgment.
- 5, Joel 3:3 - The enemy is judged for selling girls for wine.
- 6, Amos 2:8 - Unrighteous acts of Israel included the drinking of wine which had been taken for the payment of fines.
- 7, Amos 2:12 - Israel is condemned for forcing Nazarites to drink wine.
- 8, Micah 2:11 - Israelites are eager to follow false teachers who prophesy plenty of intoxicating drinks.
- 9, Nahum 1:10 - The drunkards of Nineveh will be destroyed by God.
- 10, Habakkuk 2:5 - A man is betrayed by wine.
- 11, Habakkuk 2:15 - Woe to him that gives his neighbor drink.
- 12, Habakkuk 2:16 - Drinking leads to shame.
- 13, Matthew 24:48-51 - A drinking servant is unprepared for his Lord's return.
- 14, Luke 1:15 - John the Baptist drank neither grape juice nor wine.
- 15, Luke 12:45 - Christ warned against drunkenness.
- 16, Luke 21:34 - Drunkenness will cause a person not to be ready for the Lord's return.
- 17, Romans 13:13 - Do not walk in drunkenness or immorality.
- 18, Romans 14:21 - Do not do anything that will hurt your testimony as a believer.
- 19, 1 Corinthians 5:11 - If a Christian brother is a drinker, do not associate with him.
- 20, 1 Corinthians 6:10 - Drunkards will not inherit the kingdom of God.
- 21, Galatians 5:21 - Acts of the sinful nature, such as drunkenness, will prohibit a person from inheriting the kingdom of God.
- 22, Ephesians 5:18 - In contrast to being drunk with wine, the believer is to be filled with the Spirit.
- 23, 1 Thessalonians 5:6-7 - Christians are to be alert and self-controlled, belonging to the day.  
Drunkards belong to the night and darkness.
- 24, 1 Timothy 3:2-3 - Bishops (elders) are to be temperate, sober, and not near any wine.
- 25, 1 Timothy 3:8 - Deacons are to be worthy of respect and not drinkers.
- 26, 1 Timothy 3:11 - Deacons' wives are to be temperate and sober.
- 27, Titus 1:7-8 - An overseer is to be disciplined.
- 28, Titus 2:2-3 - The older men and older women of the church are to be temperate and not addicted to wine.
- 29, 1 Peter 4:3-4 - The past life of drunkenness and carousing has no place in the Christian's life.
- 30, Isaiah 19:14 - Drunken men stagger in their vomit.
